Section 1. Section 53F-5-220 is enacted to read:				
	53F-5-220. Summer education grants.			
	(1) Subject to legislative appropriations and Subsection (2), the state board shall award			
a grant to an LEA to provide additional school days during the summer and other educational				
	summer programs.			
	(2) To qualify for a grant, an LEA shall submit an application to the state board that			
includes:				
	(a) measurable goals for the additional days or programs; and			
	(b) how the LEA intends to meet the goals described in Subsection (2)(a) through the			
	use of the grant funds.			
	(3) In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, the			
state board shall make rules specifying:				
	(a) procedures for applying for and awarding grants under this section, including the			
	duration of a grant;			
	(b) procedures and metrics to measure the administration and success of the program;

	Section 2. Appropriation.
