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7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9           This bill creates a tuition reimbursement program for new law enforcement officers.

10 **Highlighted Provisions:**

11           This bill:

- 12           ▶ creates the Law Enforcement Investment Reimbursement Program to reimburse new  
13 law enforcement officers for certain education costs;
- 14           ▶ includes a sunset date; and
- 15           ▶ makes technical and conforming changes.

16 **Money Appropriated in this Bill:**

17           This bill appropriates in fiscal year 2024:

- 18           ▶ To the Utah Board of Higher Education - Student Assistance, as a one-time  
19 appropriation:
- 20           • from the Income Tax Fund, One-time, \$5,000,000.

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30 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

31 Section 1. Section **53B-8-112.5** is enacted to read:

32 **53B-8-112.5. Law Enforcement Investment Reimbursement Program.**

33 (1) As used in this section:

34 (a) "Law enforcement agency" means the same as that term is defined in Section  
35 [53-1-102](#).

36 (b) "Law enforcement officer" means the same as that term is defined in Section  
37 [53-13-103](#).

38 (2) (a) There is created within the board the Law Enforcement Investment  
39 Reimbursement Program.

40 (b) The purpose of the program is to award grants to reimburse new law enforcement  
41 officers for education costs.

42 (3) Subject to legislative appropriation, the board shall award a grant to an applicant  
43 who:

44 (a) is hired by a law enforcement agency as a law enforcement officer for the first time  
45 on or after May 3, 2023;

46 (b) is employed with the law enforcement agency for at least five years; and

47 (c) completes a degree or certificate from a degree granting institution of higher  
48 education before or during the law enforcement officer's employment.

49 (4) (a) Subject to Subsection (4)(b), the board may award a qualified applicant up to  
50 the cost of the qualified applicant's tuition and fees.

51 (b) A grant award under Subsection (4)(a) is limited to a maximum of \$10,000.

52 (5) (a) The board shall make rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah  
53 Administrative Rulemaking Act, to:

54 (i) set deadlines for receiving grant applications and supporting documentation;

55 (ii) establish the application process; and

56 (iii) establish an appeal process for denied grant awards.

57 (b) The board shall include a disclosure on an application that the amount of the grant  
58 award is subject to funding.

111 Section 3. **Appropriation.**

112 The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
113 2023, and ending June 30, 2024. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for  
114 fiscal year 2024. Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures  
115 Act, the Legislature appropriates the following sums of money from the funds or accounts  
116 indicated for the use and support of the government of the state of Utah.
