*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **63I-1-217** is amended to read:

**63I-1-217. Repeal dates: Title 17.**

(1) Title 17, Chapter 21a, Part 3, Administration and Standards, which creates the Utah Electronic Recording Commission, is repealed July 1, 2022.

(2) In relation to Section **17-31-2**, on July 1, [~~2026~~] 2023:



28 (a) Subsection 17-31-2(1)(g), which defines "economic diversification activity," is  
29 repealed;

30 (b) Subsection 17-31-2(2)(a)(iii), relating to establishing and promoting an economic  
31 diversification activity, is repealed;

32 (c) Subsection 17-31-2(7)(b)(i) is amended to read:

33 "(i) for a purpose described in Subsection (2)(a) and subject to the limitation described  
34 in Subsection (7)(d), the greater of:"; and

35 (d) Subsection 17-31-2(7)(d)(ii), relating to a limitation on the expenditure of revenue  
36 for an economic diversification activity, is repealed.

37 (3) Subsection 17-31-5.5(2)(a)(i)(E), relating to economic diversification activity, is  
38 repealed July 1, [~~2026~~] 2023.
