Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section <b>53E-4-204</b> is amended to read:
53E-4-204. Standards and graduation requirements.
(1) The state board shall establish rigorous core standards for Utah public schools and
graduation requirements under Section 53E-3-501 for grades 9 through 12 that:

(a) are consistent with state law and federal regulations;



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28	(b) use competency-based standards and assessments;
29	(c) include instruction that stresses general financial literacy from basic budgeting to
30	financial investments, including bankruptcy education and a general financial literacy test-out
31	option; [and]
32	(d) include 0.5 units in communications completed in a course or a school sponsored
33	activity; and
34	[(d)] (e) include graduation requirements in language arts, mathematics, and science
35	that exceed:
36	(i) 3.0 units in language arts[-];
37	(ii) 2.0 units in mathematics[5]; and
38	(iii) 2.0 units in science.
39	(2) The state board shall establish competency-based standards and assessments for
40	elective courses.
