Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 53-22-101 is enacted to read:
CHAPTER 22. LAW ENFORCEMENT REQUIREMENTS
53-22-101. Prohibition on public disclosure of identity of minor homicide victim.
(1) As used in this section:



(a) "Criminal homicide" means the same as that term is defined in Section 76-5-201.
 (b) "Minor victim" means the victim of a criminal homicide if the victim is younger
 than 18 years old.
 (2) A law enforcement agency and law enforcement officer may not publicly disclose
 the name or other personally identifying information of a minor victim without the express

consent of the minor victim's parent or legal guardian.
