Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

	Section 1. Section 53B-16-112 is enacted to read:
	53B-16-112. Human trafficking educational program.
	(1) Beginning July 1, 2023, an institution of higher education or the Utah System of
High	er Education shall offer to each student in the student's first year of study an educational
progr	am regarding the prevention of human trafficking and exploitation.
	(2) An institution of higher education or the Utah System of Higher Education shall
ensur	re the program:
	(a) is taught by one or more professionals who:
	(i) have experience in investigation, prosecution, and victim advocacy related to human
traffic	cking and exploitation; and
	(ii) specialize in outreach and educational programming about human trafficking and
explo	vitation; and
	(b) includes the following components:
	(i) consistent with state law, the definitions of human trafficking, sex trafficking, and
labor	trafficking;
	(ii) an explanation of the grooming cycle;
	(iii) examples of trafficker behavior;
	(iv) risk factors for becoming a victim of human trafficking;
	(v) a demonstration showing that human trafficking can happen to any individual;
	(vi) steps to protect against becoming a victim of human trafficking; and
	(vii) how to prevent and report human trafficking.
	(3) An institution of higher education shall offer the program at least three times each
year i	in a format chosen by the institution of higher education including:
	(a) in-person; or
	(b) a virtual pre-recording.
	(4) An institution of higher education or the Utah System of Higher Education may
<u>satisf</u>	y the requirements of this section by offering a program created by a law enforcement
organ	nization or an organization of prosecutors including:
	(a) a task force created by the Attorney General related to human trafficking and
explo	vitation; or
	(b) the Office of the Attorney General.
