	Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
	WHEREAS, in accordance with Utah Code Section 49-20-201, the state participates in
1	the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program (PEHP);
	WHEREAS, the Legislature may determine what benefits to offer Utah's state
(employees;
	WHEREAS, standard fertility preservation services are procedures to preserve fertility
1	that are consistent with established medical practices or professional guidelines published by
1	the American Society of Clinical Oncology or the American Society for Reproductive
	Medicine;



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28	WHEREAS, gonadotoxic treatments are treatments for cancerous and non-cancerous
29	conditions that could potentially cause iatrogenic infertility;
30	WHEREAS, non-cancerous conditions that necessitate gonadotoxic treatments include
31	primary immunodeficiency disorders, bone marrow failure diseases, metabolic disorders, and
32	hematologic diseases; and
33	WHEREAS, iatrogenic infertility is an impairment of fertility caused directly or
34	indirectly by medicine, surgery, or radiation:
35	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah
36	directs PEHP to provide coverage to state employees and employee beneficiaries for standard
37	fertility preservation services when a medically necessary gonadotoxic treatment may directly
38	or indirectly cause iatrogenic infertility.
39	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the coverage shall include consultations,
40	medications, and procedures for cryopreservation.
41	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the coverage shall include the costs of
42	cryopreservation for:
43	► at least five years; or
44	• if the covered individual is younger than 18 years old, until the
45	individual is at least 23 years old.
46	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that PEHP may only provide coverage for cancerous
47	conditions or a condition that requires a bone marrow transplant.
