Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 53F-4-501 is amended to read:
53F-4-501. Definitions.
As used in this part:
(1) (a) "Certified online course provider" means a provider that the state board



28	approves to offer courses through the Statewide Online Education Program.
29	(b) "Certified online course provider" does not include an entity described in
30	Subsections 53F-4-504(1)(a) through (c).
31	(2) "Credit" means credit for a high school course, or the equivalent for a middle
32	school course, as determined by the state board.
33	(3) "Eligible student" means a student:
34	(a) who intends to take a course for middle school or high school credit; and
35	(b) (i) who is enrolled in a district school or charter school in Utah; or
36	(ii) (A) who attends a private school or home school; and
37	(B) whose custodial parent is a resident of Utah.
38	(4) "High school" means grade 9, 10, 11, or 12.
39	(5) "Middle school" means:
40	(a) grade 7 or 8[-]; or
41	(b) if the student attends a middle or junior high school, grade 6.
42	(6) "Online course" means a course of instruction offered by the Statewide Online
43	Education Program through the use of digital technology.
44	(7) "Plan for college and career readiness" means the same as that term is defined in
45	Section 53E-2-304.
46	(8) "Primary LEA of enrollment" means the LEA in which an eligible student is
47	enrolled for courses other than online courses offered through the Statewide Online Education
48	Program.
49	(9) "Released-time" means a period of time during the regular school day a student is
50	excused from school at the request of the student's parent pursuant to rules of the state board.
51	Section 2. Effective date.
52	This bill takes effect on July 1, 2023.
