Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 4-11-106 is amended to read:
4-11-106. Consent of county bee inspector to sell or transport diseased bees.
[(1) A person may not house or keep bees in a hive unless the hive is equipped with
movable frames to all the hive's parts so that access to the hive can be had without difficulty.]
[(2)] No person who owns or has possession of bees $[(]]$, whether queens or workers $[]$,

- with knowledge that [they] the bees are infected with terminal disease, parasites, or pests, or
- with knowledge that [they] the bees have been exposed to terminal disease, parasites, or pests,
- 30 shall sell, barter, give away, or move the bees, colonies, or apiary equipment without the
- 31 consent of the county bee inspector or the department.
