26 (1) A person may not house or keep bees in a hive unless the hive is equipped with a movable [frames to] frame, or the functional equivalent of a movable frame, that allows access, 27 without difficulty, to all the hive's parts [so that access to the hive can be had without 28 29 difficulty.], as defined in rule made by the department in accordance with Section 4-11-103. 30 (2) No person who owns or has possession of bees (whether queens or workers) with 31 knowledge that they are infected with terminal disease, parasites, or pests, or with knowledge that they have been exposed to terminal disease, parasites, or pests, shall sell, barter, give away, 32 33 or move the bees, colonies, or apiary equipment without the consent of the county bee

34 inspector or the department.
