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| 29 | Section 1. Section 53E-9-205 is enacted to read: |

| 31 | (1) As used in this section: |
| 32 | (a) "Gender identity" means the same as that term is defined in Section <u>34A-5-102</u> . |
| 33 | (b) "Sex" means the biological, physical condition of being male or female, determined |
| 34 | by an individual's genetics and anatomy at birth. |
| 35 | (2) In accordance with Section 53E-2-201, each school and each local governing board |
| 36 | shall ensure that no policy or action of the school or LEA: |
| 37 | (a) operates to shield any student's information from the student's parent; and |
| 38 | (b) interferes with a parent's: |
| 39 | (i) fundamental parental right and primary responsibility to direct the education of the |
