29	77-23d-102. Definitions.
30	As used in this chapter:
31	(1) (a) "Authorized public property" means property on which a government building is
32	located.
33	(b) "Authorized public property" does not include public streets or public sidewalks.
34	(2) (a) "Government entity" means the state, a county, a municipality, a higher
35	education institution, a local district, a special service district, or any other political subdivision
36	of the state or an administrative subunit of any political subdivision[ <del>, including</del> ].
37	(b) Government entity includes a law enforcement entity or any other investigative
