The Government Operations Committee recommends **H.B. 21**, OPEN AND PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. K. Briscoe, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 21**, OPEN AND PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 10, Lines 290 through 292:
  - 290 (3) (a) (i) A public body holding a meeting that is open to the public shall allow a
  - 291 <u>reasonable opportunity for the public to provide verbal comment that is germane to the</u> <u>topics</u>
  - 292 <u>to be considered during the meeting</u> } <u>authority of the public body</u>.
- 2. Page 10, Line 303 through Page 11, Line 306:
  - 303 (c) The resolution, rule, or ordinance described in Subsection (3)(b) may limit public
  - 304 <u>verbal and written comments to topics that are germane to the</u> {<u>topics to be</u> <u>considered during</u> <u>305 the meeting</u> } <u>authority of the public body</u> .
  - 306 (4) Subsection (3) does not apply to the Legislature, a legislative committee, or <u>another</u>
