The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 75**, STATE COMMEMORATIVE PERIODS AMENDMENTS, by Representative N. Thurston, with the following amendments:

 - 57 { (k) } (j) Rachael Runyan/Missing and Exploited Children's Day, on August 26, the
 - anniversary of the day three-year-old Rachael Runyan was kidnaped from a playground in
 - 59 Sunset, Utah, to:
 - (i) encourage individuals to make child safety a priority;
 - 61 (ii) remember the importance of continued efforts to reunite missing children with their
 - 62 families; and
 - 63 (iii) honor Rachael Runyan and all Utah children who have been abducted or exploited;
