Mr. President,

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 187**, VETERINARY PRACTICE AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. L. Kohler, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 14:*

12 This bill:
13 ▶ exempts {~~an individual who is testing~~} certain individuals who test
a bovine for pregnancy from the requirement to
14 be licensed under the Veterinary Practice Act.

2. *Page 4, Lines 99 through 102:*

99 perform teeth floating; [~~and~~]
100 (b) administers or uses a sedative drug only if the individual is under the direct
101 supervision of a veterinarian in accordance with Subsection 58-28-502(2)(a)(iv)[~~;~~]; and
102 (17) an individual testing a bovine for pregnancy {~~.~~} if the individual has:

(a) obtained a masters degree or higher in animal reproductive physiology; and
(b) completed at least 8 hours of continuing education on animal reproductive
physiology within the previous 2-year period.
