Mr. President,

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 187**, VETERINARY PRACTICE AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. L. Kohler, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 14:
 - 12 This bill:
 - exempts { an individual who is testing } certain individuals who test
 a bovine for pregnancy from the requirement to
 - 14 be licensed under the Veterinary Practice Act.
- 2. Page 4, Lines 99 through 102:
 - 99 perform teeth floating; [and]
 - 100 (b) administers or uses a sedative drug only if the individual is under the direct
 - 101 supervision of a veterinarian in accordance with Subsection 58-28-502(2)(a)(iv)[-]; and
 - 102 (17) an individual testing a bovine for pregnancy {---}} if the individual has:

(a) obtained a masters degree or higher in animal reproductive physiology; and
 (b) completed at least 8 hours of continuing education on animal reproductive
 physiology within the previous 2-year period.
