The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 193**, ONLINE EDUCATION COURSE AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. Birkeland, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 31 through 33:
 - 31 (2) (a) [A] An LEA may not count a student [may not count as] for more than one
 - 32 [FTE] ADM, unless the { student intends to complete high school graduation requirements, and
 - 233 exit high school, early, in accordance with are included in the student's plan for college and career readiness as described in Subsection (5)(a).
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 43 through 47:*
 - 43 (5) A student enrolled in an online course may earn more credits in a year than the
 - number of credits a student may earn in a year by taking a full course load during the regular
 - school day in the student's primary LEA of enrollment:
 - 46 (a) { if the student intends to complete high school graduation requirements, and exit
 - 47 high school, early, in accordance with student's plan for college and career readiness; or
