Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 197**, HIGHER EDUCATION FINANCIAL AID AMENDMENTS, by Representative T. Clancy, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 5, Lines 128 through 130:*

- 128 (4) A student is eligible for a promise grant until the student:
129 (a) earns a first bachelor's degree {~~or technical college certificate~~} ; or
130 (b) completes 120 credit hours.

2. *Page 8, Lines 231 through 236:*

- 231 (4) A qualifying military veteran may receive a program grant [] {+} until {+
-} [the earlier of the
232 following occurs] {~~when~~} :
233 (a) the qualifying military veteran completes the requirements for a bachelor's
degree;
234 or
235 (b) [~~12 months from the time that~~] the qualifying military veteran receives [~~an initial~~
236 program grant] the maximum award that the board sets.
