Mr. Speaker,

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 220**, EMISSIONS REDUCTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative A. Stoddard, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 39 through 53:
  - 39 (2) By no later than December 31, 2024, the division shall complete {
  - 40 <u>(a)</u> an air emissions inventory of point sources in the applicable geographic area that
  - 41 <u>emit</u> { <u>bromine</u> } <u>halogen.</u> { ; and
  - 42 <u>(b) an emissions reduction plan to reduce bromine in the applicable geographic area as</u>
  - 43 <u>of December 31, 2026:</u>
  - 44 <u>(i) by 90% compared to a baseline of calendar year 2017 for bromine; or </u>
  - 45 <u>(ii) if the division determines that the goal set under Subsection (2)(b)(i) is not feasible,</u>
  - 46 <u>by a percent reduction target compared to a baseline of calendar year 2017 that is practicable</u>
  - 47 with available control technologies.
  - 48 <u>(3) In determining for purposes of this section the baseline of calendar year</u> 2017, the
  - 49 <u>division shall supplement the division's data with data collected through calendar vear 2023 to</u>
  - 50 <u>address data gaps, shutdowns, and shortcomings related to the 2017 baseline inventory.</u>
  - 51 (3) Upon completion, the division shall publish the air emissions inventory { and
  - 52 <u>emissions reduction plan required under Subsection (2)</u>} on the division's public
