The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **H.B. 226**, SALE OF A FIREARM AMENDMENTS, by Representative A. Cory Maloy, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 226**, SALE OF A FIREARM AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 6, Lines 168 through 173:
 - 168 (7) If an individual uses the process under Subsection (2), the individual is not
 - required, based on the information the individual receives from the bureau, to:
 - (a) make a report to a law enforcement agency; or
 - 171 (b) cancel the sale of the firearm {...} except as otherwise prohibited by Section 76-10-503(8).
 - 172 (8) Except as provided in Subsection (9), after responding to a request under
 - Subsection (2), the bureau shall immediately dispose of all information related to the request.
