The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 258**, MOTOR VEHICLE LIGHT AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. Rohner, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 27 through Page 2, Line 38:*

- 27 41-6a-1603. Lights and illuminating devices -- Duty to display -- Time.
