Abbott, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **3rd Sub. H.B. 385**, MENTALLY ILL OFFENDERS AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 24, Lines 723 through 726:
  - 723 (iii) A health insurance company may not deny coverage for court-ordered treatment or
  - 724 <u>supervision of a defendant with a mental condition</u> { that } <u>solely based on the</u>

    <u>fact that the treatment or supervision is ordered by a court if the treatment or supervision is medically necessary and would otherwise be a covered benefit</u>
  - 725 <u>under the defendant's insurance plan</u> { <u>based on the fact that the treatment or supervision is</u>
  - 726 ordered by a court \ .
