1. *Page 24, Lines 723 through 726:*

723            (iii) A health insurance company may not deny coverage for court-ordered treatment  
                  or  
724            supervision of a defendant with a mental condition {~~that~~} solely based on the  
                  fact that the treatment or supervision is ordered by a court if the treatment or  
                  supervision is medically necessary and would otherwise be a covered benefit  
725            under the defendant's insurance plan {~~based on the fact that the treatment or~~  
                  ~~supervision is~~  
726            ~~ordered by a court~~} .
