Mr. President,

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 396, PALEONTOLOGICAL RESOURCES AMENDMENTS**, by Representative J. Elison, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 32 through 34:*

- 32 (ii) an accredited facility meeting federal curation standards; [✗]
33 (iii) for the purposes described in Subsection (3)(c), a paleontology museum;
or
34 [(iii)] (iv) an appropriate state park.

2. *Page 2, Lines 44 through 46:*

- 44 (i) a facility designated by the museum through memoranda of agreement; [✗]
45 (ii) for the purposes described in Subsection (3)(c), a paleontology museum;
or
46 [(ii)] (iii) a place of reburial.

3. *Page 3, Lines 68 through 69:*

- 68 (c) A city that has a paleontology museum may retain, curate, and manage paleontological specimens, paleontological
69 collections, and paleontological resources recovered on lands owned or controlled by the
city.
