Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 400**, SCHOOL ABSENTEEISM AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. N. Johnson, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 61:
 - (h) providing { an evidence-based } a system of supports that:
 - 59 {<u>(i) is structured in tiers, with each tier addressing teaming, accurate data</u>
 - 60 analysis, and systematic action; and
 - (i) is evidence-based as defined in Section 53G-11-303;
 - (ii) integrates multiple tiers that provide increasingly intensive interventions for students at risk for or experiencing chronic absenteeism; and
 - 61 { (ii) } (iii) includes dropout or chronic absenteeism interventions that seek to determine
- 2. Page 3, Line 74:
 - 74 (b) absences without a valid excuse.
 - (7) The state board shall make rules in accordance with Titley 53G, Chapter 3, <u>Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, to define the tiers of intervention and</u> <u>supports described in Subsection (2)(h)(ii) which shall:</u>
 - (a) be developed to:
 - (i) maximize student achievement;
 - (ii) reduce behavior problems; and
 - (iii) increase long-term success; and
 - (b) in higher tiers of intervention and support, provide targeted interventions that increase structure, support, and feedback to address current attendance deficits







experienced by students.

- 3. Page 5, Lines 137 through 139:
 - (b) use another evidence-based program; or

 - plan that is evidence-informed as defined in Section 53G-11-303.
