The Government Operations Committee recommends H.B. 451, STATE ENTITY

RESTRICTIONS, by Representative K. Hall, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on 1st

Sub. H.B. 451, STATE ENTITY RESTRICTIONS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 31 through 34:
  - 31 (1) (a) As used in this section, "prohibited submission" means a submission, statement,
  - 32 <u>or document that requires a person to articulate the person's</u> {<u>personal</u>} <u>beliefs or</u> <u>position on a</u>
  - 33 policy or initiative that promotes differential treatment based on race, color, ethnicity, <u>sex,</u>
  - 34 <u>national origin, or age.</u>
- 2. Page 3, Lines 62 through 67:
  - 62 (4) If federal law requires an institution to accept a prohibited {<u>statement</u>} <u>submission</u>, the
  - 63 <u>institution:</u>
  - 64 (a) may accept the prohibited {<u>statement</u>} <u>submission</u> only to the extent required under federal law;
  - 65 <u>and</u>
  - 66 (b) shall limit consideration of the information contained in the prohibited {=
    statement}

  - 67 the extent necessary to satisfy the requirement under federal law.
- 3. Page 3, Lines 74 through 76:
