The Government Operations Committee recommends **H.B. 451**, STATE ENTITY RESTRICTIONS, by Representative K. Hall, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 451**, STATE ENTITY RESTRICTIONS with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 31 through 34:*
