Mr. Speaker,

The Economic Development and Workforce Services Committee recommends **H.B. 482**, ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESOURCES AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. Owens, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 482**, ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESOURCES AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 31 through 36:
 - 31 (2) The office may distribute the money from the grant program to a private landowner:
 - 32 (a) that applies to the office, in a manner prescribed by the office, to receive all or part
 - of the money contained in the grant program; and
 - 34 (b) for identifying and protecting archaeological resources on the landowner's property,
 - 35 <u>if the private landowner contributes</u> { <u>an amount of</u>} <u>money</u> <u>, matching</u> <u>non-state grants or in-kind value,</u> equal to or greater than the amount of
 - 36 money the landowner receives from the grant program.
