The Health and Human Services Committee recommends **S.B. 16**, SEX CHARACTERISTIC SURGICAL PROCEDURES, by Senator M. S. Kennedy, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 16**, TRANSGENDER MEDICAL TREATMENTS AND PROCEDURES AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 14 through 15:
 - requires the Department of Health and Human Services { to study } to conduct a systematic review of the medical evidence regarding hormonal
 - 15 transgender treatments and provide recommendations to the Legislature;
- 2. Page 2, Line 48 through 56:
 - 48 <u>26B-1-214.</u> {-Study } <u>Systematic medical evidence review</u> of hormonal transgender treatments.
 - 49 (1) As used in this section, "hormonal transgender treatment" means the same as that
