The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 47**, INCARCERATED YOUTH EDUCATION AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. R. Owens, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 32 through 37:
 - 32 (c) "Student" means an individual who is:
 - 33 (i) in the custody of the Division of Juvenile Justice and Youth Services {-within the timeframe of
 - 34 the course at any time a course is being offered, including:
 - 35 (A) individuals in the legal custody of the Division of Juvenile Justice Services; and
 - 36 (B) individuals who are housed in a detention center that the Division of Juvenile
 - 37 <u>Justice Services operates</u>; and
- 2. Page 2, Lines 44 through 45:
 - (b) a consistent, two-year, flexible schedule of higher education courses delivered
 - 45 through interactive video conferencing <u>, in-person, or online methods</u> to students;
