The Transportation, Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 125**, TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE AMENDMENTS, by Senator C. H. Wilson, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 9 through 16:
 - 9 This bill designates the ASPIRE Engineering Research Center at Utah State University
 - 10 as the <u>lead</u> research center for strategic planning for electrification of transportation
 - 11 infrastructure and requires certain actions.
 - 12 Highlighted Provisions:
 - This bill:

 - 15 <u>lead</u> research center for strategic planning for electrification of transportation
 - 16 infrastructure in this state;
- 2. Page 3, Line 68 through 71:
 - 68 (1) The ASPIRE Engineering Research Center at Utah State University is designated

as

- 69 the lead research center to coordinate and lead the initiative described in this part.
- 70 (2) The research center shall:
- 71 (a) direct and carry out the mission of the initiative;

- (d) consider and approve the budget proposed by the project director for the
- 107 expenditure of funds for the { operation of the research center and } initiative; and
- (e) review expenditures authorized by the project director made before October 1,
- 109 2023.
