The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 172**, VEHICLE SALES AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. L. Ipson, with the following amendments:

1. Page 8, Lines 220 through 233:

- 220 (14) (a) Subject to Subsection (14)(b), a licensed vehicle dealer may:
- 221 (i) sell a vehicle to a buyer without the buyer being required to appear in person at one
- 222 of the dealer's licensed places of business;
- 223 (ii) collect a buyer's signature <u>or buyer's electronic signature</u> on a purchase contract and related purchase documents;
- 224 (iii) collect payment electronically; and
- (iv) deliver a vehicle to a buyer at the buyer's home or place of business, or at one of
- 226 <u>the dealer's licensed places of business.</u>
- 227 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (14)(a), a vehicle purchase contract is not executed
- 228 <u>until the contract is countersigned by the licensed dealer at one of the dealer's licensed</u> places of
- 229 <u>business.</u>
- 230 (c) Notwithstanding Subsections (14)(a) and (b), Subsection (1)(n) is construed to
- 231 prevent a dealer, salesperson, or any other representative of a dealership from selling,
- 232 <u>displaying, or offering a motor vehicle for sale from the dealer's, salesperson's, or any</u> <u>other</u>
- 233 representative's home or other unlicensed location.
