The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 262**, GOVERNMENT RECORDS AMENDMENTS, by Senator M. K. McKell, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 9, Lines 249 through 251:
 - 249 {<u>(c) If a respondent fails to submit a written statement under this</u> Subsection (4), the
 - 250 <u>respondent may not testify, present evidence, or comment on the issues at a hearing</u> <u>held under</u>
 - 251 <u>this section.</u>}
- 2. Page 9, Lines 255 through 261:

 - 256 <u>not the respondent appears at a hearing scheduled under Subsection (3), or if the</u> respondent
 - 257 <u>submits a written statement under Subsection (4) but</u> } <u>or</u> fails to appear at the <u>hearing, the</u>
 - 258 <u>committee shall:</u>
 - 259 (a) cancel the hearing; or
 - 260 (b) hold the hearing { without the respondent testifying, presenting evidence, or
 - 261 <u>commenting on the issues considered at the hearing</u> }

- *3. Page 9, Lines 266 through 267:*
 - 266 (ii) allow the respondent to testify, present evidence, and comment on the issues if the
 - 267 <u>respondent</u> {<u>has submitted a written statement under Subsection (4) and</u>} appears at the hearing.
