Representative **Norman K Thurston** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 57 through 58:
 - 57 (b) Upon application to the attorney general by any person denied the rights guaranteed
 - by this section, the attorney general shall investigate and seek to conciliate the matter.
 - (5) The requirements of this section do not apply to a Utah business with twenty or fewer employees

<u>if:</u>

- (a) restrictions based on immunity status are necessary to protect:
 - (i) valuable property;
 - (ii) livestock; or
 - (iii) the health or safety of one or more employees;
- (b) the business does not differentiate between forms of immunity status;
- (c) the business allows a recent negative infection test as an alternative to documenting immunity status; and
- (d) the business does not capture or retain any information about the individual's immunity status or test results.
