Page 3, Lines 60 through 69: 60 (b) the local school board shall provide the employee the opportunity to return to 61 regular work if the investigation: 62 (i) concludes without leading to criminal charges; {-and-} 63 (ii) does not { substantiate wrongdoing on the part } result in the conviction of the employee; and 64 (c) if the investigation { substantiates wrongdoing on the part } results in the conviction of the employee { or leads to criminal charges } : **65** 66 (i) the local school board shall take further employment action in response to the 67 { substantiated wrongdoing or criminal charges } **conviction**, including leave without pay or termination; and 68 (ii) the employee shall pay back all salary compensation that the employee received

during the paid administrative leave period described in Subsection (5)(a).
