Senator **Luz Escamilla** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 29, Line 871:*

871 (b) comply with the antidiscrimination provisions of 42 U.S.C. Sec. 2000d. **and Subsection (11)** ;
and

2. *Page 30, Lines 900 through 901:*

900 (b) demonstrate that the private school continues to meet the eligibility requirements of
901 this section.

(11) (a) The state board shall make rules, in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, to establish a process:

(i) through which a scholarship student or the scholarship student's parent may report and seek redress of violations of the antidiscrimination requirement described in this section; and

(ii) that is similar to the federal process described in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 2000d.

(b) A school that has violated the antidiscrimination requirement described in this section, as determined through the process described in Subsection (11)(a):

(i) is not an eligible school; and

(ii) may not provide services to any scholarship student under the program.
