 - 871 (b) comply with the antidiscrimination provisions of 42 U.S.C. Sec. 2000d. and Subsection (11); and
- 2. Page 30, Lines 900 through 901:
 - 900 (b) demonstrate that the private school continues to meet the eligibility requirements of
 - 901 this section.
 - (11) (a) The state board shall make rules, in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, to establish a process:
 - (i) through which a scholarship student or the scholarship student's parent may report and seek redress of violations of the antidiscrimination requirement described in this section; and
 - (ii) that is similar to the federal process described in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 2000d.
 - (b) A school that has violated the antidiscrimination requirement described in this section, as determined through the process described in Subsection (11)(a):
 - (i) is not an elligible school; and
 - (ii) may not provide services to any scholarship student under the program.
