 - (a) be developed to:
 - (i) maximize student achievement;
 - (ii) reduce behavior problems; and
 - (iii) increase long-term success; and
 - (b) in higher tiers of intervention and support, provide targeted interventions that increase structure, support, and feedback to address current attendance deficits experienced by students.
