**SENATE RULES RESOLUTION - SENATE COMMITTEE SECURITY**

Senator **Curtis S. Bramble** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 77:*

- 58            ~~{(1)}~~    A member of the public attending a meeting of a Senate committee may not:
