Highlighted Provisions: This bill: • provides funding for flood related expenses; • provides funding for other purposes, as indicated; and • provides intent language. Money Appropriated in this Bill: This bill appropriates \$5,000,000 in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2023, all of which is from the General Fund. This bill appropriates (\$5,000,000) in expendable funds and accounts for fiscal year 2023, all of which is from the General Fund. This bill appropriates \$8,000,000 in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2024, including: • \$5,000,000 from the General Fund; and • \$3,000,000 from various sources as detailed in this bill. This bill appropriates (\$5,000,000) in expendable funds and accounts for fiscal year 2024, all of which is from the General Fund. Other Special Clauses: Section 1 of this bill takes effect immediately. Section 2 of this bill takes effect on July 1, 2023.
