LONG TITLE
General Description:
This bill supplements or reduces appropriations otherwise provided for the support and
operation of state government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023
and for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024.
Highlighted Provisions:
This bill:
provides funding for flood related expenses;
provides funding for other purposes, as indicated; and
provides intent language.
Money Appropriated in this Bill:
This bill appropriates \$5,000,000 in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2023, all of
which is from the General Fund.
This bill appropriates (\$5,000,000) in expendable funds and accounts for fiscal year 2023, al
of which is from the General Fund.
This bill appropriates \$8,000,000 in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2024,
including:
► \$5,000,000 from the General Fund; and
► \$3,000,000 from various sources as detailed in this bill.
This bill appropriates (\$5,000,000) in expendable funds and accounts for fiscal year 2024, al
of which is from the General Fund.
Other Special Clauses:
Section 1 of this bill takes effect immediately. Section 2 of this bill takes effect on July 1,
2023.
