LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends bicycle and moped handlebar requirements.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ amends requirements for bicycle and moped operators to maintain control; and
- ▶ removes the requirement for a person operating a bicycle or moped to keep at least one hand on the handlebars at all times.

41-6a-1112, as renumbered and amended by Laws of Utah 2005, Chapter 2

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **41-6a-1112** is amended to read:

41-6a-1112. Maintaining control of bicycles and mopeds.

H→ (1) As used in this section, "safe operation" means exercising reasonable care and caution under existing roadway conditions with consideration of the specific type and intended use of the bicycle or moped. ←H

H→ [(1)] (2) ←H A person operating a bicycle or moped shall maintain control of the bicycle or moped at all times.
