59 **adult Medicaid program.**

60 (1) As used in this section, "targeted adult Medicaid program" means the same as that term
61 is defined in Section 26B-3-207.

62 (2) The department may implement the delivery system adjustments authorized under

- 63 Subsection (3) only on the later of:
- 64 (a) July 1, 2023; and
- 65 (b) the department determining that the Medicaid program, including providers and
- 66 managed care organizations, are satisfying the metrics established in collaboration
- 67 with the [~~working group convened under Subsection 26B-3-138(2)~~] Behavioral
- 68 Health Delivery Working Group.
- 69 (3) The department may, for individuals who are enrolled in the targeted adult Medicaid
- 70 program:
- 71 (a) integrate the delivery of behavioral and physical health in certain counties; and
- 72 (b) deliver behavioral health services through an accountable care organization where
- 73 implemented.
- 74 (4) Before implementing the delivery system adjustments described in Subsection (3) in a
- 75 county, the department shall, at a minimum, seek input from:
- 76 (a) individuals who qualify for the targeted adult Medicaid program who reside in the
- 77 county;
- 78 (b) the county's executive officer, legislative body, and other county officials who are
- 79 involved in the delivery of behavioral health services;
- 80 (c) the local mental health authority and local substance abuse authority that serves the
- 81 county;
- 82 (d) Medicaid managed care organizations operating in the state, including Medicaid
- 83 accountable care organizations;
- 84 (e) providers of physical or behavioral health services in the county who provide
- 85 services to enrollees in the targeted adult Medicaid program in the county; and
- 86 (f) other individuals that the department deems necessary.
- 87 (5) If the department provides Medicaid coverage through a managed care delivery system
- 88 under this section, the department shall include language in the department's managed
- 89 care contracts that require the managed care plan to:
- 90 (a) be in compliance with federal Medicaid managed care requirements;
- 91 (b) timely and accurately process authorizations and claims in accordance with Medicaid
- 92 policy and contract requirements;
- 93 (c) adequately reimburse providers to maintain adequacy of access to care;
- 94 (d) provide care management services sufficient to meet the needs of Medicaid eligible
- 95 individuals enrolled in the managed care plan's plan; and
- 96 (e) timely resolve any disputes between a provider or enrollee with the managed care

97 plan.

99 comply with the terms of the managed care organization's contract.
