21	Section 1. Section 36-11-302 is amended to read:

24	[A person may not seek to influence the vote of any legislator through communication with the
25	legislator's employer.]
26	(1) As used in this section:
27	(a) "Elected official" means:

(i) a member of the Legislature;

30	(iii) a member of a board of education; or
31	(iv) the mayor of a city, town, or metro township.
32	(b) "Elected official" includes a person who is appointed to fill a vacancy in the office of
33	an elected official described in Subsection (1)(a).
34	(2) A person may not communicate with an elected official's employer with the intent to
35	influence, coerce, or intimidate the elected official's action on a vote or another official
36	<u>act.</u>
37	Section 2. Effective date.
