- 23 (1) As used in this section, "child care provider" means an entity that holds a license or
- certificate from the Department of Health and Human Services in accordance with Title
- 25 26B, Chapter 2, Part 4, Child Care Licensing.
- 26 (2) (a) On or before June 30, 2023, the office shall award a full child care subsidy or
- grant for an income-eligible child.
- 28 (b) The office shall make the award described in Subsection [(1)(a)] (2)(a):

31	[(2)] (3) (a) Beginning on July 1, 2023 and subject to Subsection (3)(b), the office may

36	(B) a child who has at least one parent or legal guardian working as a full-time

44	[(3)] (a) On or before June 30, 2023, and subject to Subsection $[(3)(b)]$ (4)(b), the
45	office shall determine the amount of a child care subsidy or grant based on the
46	income-eligible child's enrollment in child care.
47	(b) To qualify for a child care subsidy or grant under Subsection $[(3)(a)]$ $(4)(a)$, an
48	income-eligible child shall be enrolled in child care for a minimum of eight hours per
49	month.
50	(c) On or after July 1, 2023, and subject to Subsection [(3)(d)] (4)(d), the office shall
51	determine the amount of a child care subsidy or grant based on the income-eligible
52	child's attendance in child care.
53	(d) To qualify for a child care subsidy or grant under Subsection $[(3)(e)]$ $(4)(e)$, an
54	income-eligible child shall attend child care for a minimum of eight hours per month.
