	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
	Section 1. Section 53F-2-526 is enacted to read:
	53F-2-526. Appropriations for teaching supplies and materials.
	(1) As used in this section:
	(a) "Classroom teacher" means a teacher who:
	(i) is assigned by an LEA in a permanent teacher position filled by one teacher or two
(or more job-sharing teachers employed by an LEA;
	(ii) is licensed and paid on an LEA's salary schedule;
	(iii) is employed for an entire contract period; and
	(iv) is primarily responsible to provide instruction or a combination of instructional
	and counseling services to students in public schools.
	(b) "Teaching supplies and materials" means consumable and non-consumable items
	that are used for educational purposes by teachers in classroom activities that are approved by
<u>t</u>	he LEA.
	(2) For the fiscal year that begins July 1, 2024, the state board shall distribute money
2	appropriated for teaching supplies and materials as follows:
	(a) \$500 to each classroom teacher position for pre-kindergarten special education and
	kindergarten through grade 6; and
	(b) \$250 to each classroom teacher position for grades 7 through 12.
	Section 2. FY 2025 Appropriation.
	The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
	2024, and ending June 30, 2025. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for
	fiscal year 2025.
	Subsection 2(a). Operating and Capital Budgets.
