VACCINE DISCLOSURE AMENDMENTS

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill enacts a conditional disclosure requirement on health care providers who administer vaccines.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ defines terms; and
- ▶ establishes disclosure requirements for a health care provider that earns incentive compensation for administering a vaccine.

Other Special Clauses:

This bill provides a special effective date.

Utah Code Sections Affected:

ENACTS:

26B-4-321.1, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **26B-4-321.1** is enacted to read:



26 **26B-4-321.1. Disclosure of vaccination compensation.**

27 (1) As used in this section, "incentive compensation" means any payment or other
28 benefit that:

29 (a) serves as a reward to a health care provider;

30 (b) the health care provider may only earn, in whole or in part, for administering a
31 vaccine; and

32 (c) is in addition to the health care provider's regular compensation, salary, or wage.

33 (2) If a health care provider, as defined in Section [76B-3-403](#), is a candidate to receive
34 incentive compensation for the administration of a vaccine to a patient, the health care provider
35 shall make a disclosure to the patient:

36 (a) prior to administering the vaccine;

37 (b) in writing, including:

38 (i) by email;

39 (ii) as part of the patient's contract for services;

40 (iii) as part of other written communications or set of disclosures made to the patient;

41 or

42 (iv) as a separate disclosure;

43 (c) showing the total value of incentive compensation; and

44 (d) identifying the individual or entity obligated to pay the incentive compensation.

45 Section 2. **Effective date.**

46 This bill takes effect on May 1, 2025.
