Section 1. Section 58-55-107 is enacted to read:

- (2) when creating a sample contract described in Subsection (1), engage an attorney with at least 10 years' experience drafting and reviewing residential construction contracts to advise and assist the division in creating the sample contract; and
 - (3) post each sample contract on the division's website.

This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
