Section 1. Section 41-6a-1112 is amended to read:
41-6a-1112. Maintaining control of bicycles and mopeds.
(1) A person operating a bicycle or moped shall maintain control of the bicycle or
moped at all times.

[(1)] (2) A person operating a bicycle or moped may not carry any package, bundle, or		
article [which prevents the use of both hands in the control and operation of the bicycle or		
moped.] that prevents the operator from maintaining control and safe operation of the bicycle		
or moped.		
[(2) A person operating a bicycle or moped shall keep at least one hand on the		
handlebars at all times.]		
Section 2. Effective date.		
This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
