8	General Description:
9	This bill requires certain information to be communicated to a patient receiving a
10	contact lens prescription.
11	Highlighted Provisions:
12	This bill:
13	requires an optometrist or physician who is prescribing a contact lens to:
14	 provide certain information to the patient during the patient consultation;
15	 document certain information related to the patient interaction; and
16	 provide a patient with a prescription for a specific brand or manufacturer, if
17	medically appropriate, at the patient's request; and
18	 prohibits an optometrist or physician who prescribes a contact lens to a patient from
19	selling a contact lens to that patient.

29	Section 1. Section 58-16a-306 is amended to read:
30	58-16a-306. Contact lens prescription Qualifications Requirements for a
31	contact lens prescription Prohibition on prescription and sale.
32	(1) An optometrist or physician issuing a contact lens prescription shall:
33	(a) be licensed under this title to practice in Utah;
34	(b) ensure the final contact lens prescription is accurate;
35	(c) inform the patient that the patient may have options among several contact lens
36	brands or manufacturers;
37	(d) ask the patient if the patient has a preference for a particular brand or manufacturer;
38	<u>and</u>
39	(e) document the information described in Subsection (1)(c) and (1)(d) in a clear
40	statement on:
41	(i) the document required by federal law acknowledging that the patient received the
42	contact lens prescription; or
43	(ii) the digital prescription if the optometrist or physician is providing a digital
44	prescription;
45	[(e)] (f) present a written copy of the prescription to the patient after fitting; and
46	[(d)] (g) provide a copy of the patient's contact lens prescription to a person who sells
47	contact lenses upon the request of the patient or the person selling the contact lenses.
48	(2) An optometrist or physician may not be held liable as a result of providing a
49	prescription to a patient as required by Subsection (1).
50	(3) Application of the provisions of this section shall be consistent with 45 C.F.R. Parts
51	160 and 164, Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable Health Information.
52	(4) If the patient requests a brand or manufacturer that the prescribing optometrist or
53	physician determines is medically appropriate for the patient, the prescribing optometrist or
54	physician shall offer the patient a prescription that includes the brand or manufacturer that the
55	patient requests.
56	(5) If an optometrist or physician issues a contact lens prescription to a patient, the
57	optometrist or physician may not sell the prescribed contact lens to the patient.
58	Section 2. Effective date.

This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
